AN ASTRONOMER-PHYSICIST said he believed that chlorophyll, a key compound of life on earth, exists in outer space.

His findings, if correct, would mean that life in forms familiar to man can exist on other planets both in the earth's galaxy and perhaps throughout the universe.

THE SCIENTIST is Dr. Fred M. Johnson of Pasadena, a researcher for Electro-Optical Systems, Inc., a subsidiary of the Xerox Corporation. His conclusion was announced at a special science symposium at the University of Calif.

# The News in Brief

THE TIMES OF London carried a six-column advertisement signed by 1,470 professors and lecturers of 29 British universities and research institutes demanding Britain withdraw its support of U.S. policy in Vietnam.

THE KREMLIN gave a direct warning to Washington that its Viet Nam policy would have to change before United States- Soviet relations could be put on the upgrade.

President Nikolai Podgorny told the new United States ambassador Llewellyn E. Thompson, that the Viet Nam war is a complicating factor in efforts for the closer cooperation between Russia and the United States proposed by President Johnson.

LT. GEN. RICHARD L. Bohannon, surgeon general of the air force, said that air force physicians soon will begin stocking frozen blood in south-east Asia for use in the treatment of service men wounded in Viet Nam.

The frozen blood will be a backstop, to be used only when stocks of fresh blood run out either because of extra heavy casualties or an interruption of fresh blood shipments from the United States.





# Final Love Letter of Patrice Lumumba

The most tragic event in the history of modern Africa was the cruel murder of freedom and the Congo's staunchest patriot, Patrice Lumumba-a murder participated in and planned by Belgium, the United States and a diabolical collusion of all of the nations of the Western world.

With the murder of Lumumba came the turning point of the drive toward true independence and dignity for all African nations. Following his downfall, Western powers launched an all-out offensive toward subversion of every African state which sought to seek freedom from the grip of neo-colonialism and exploitation. Today, the countries which have managed to escape this vise-like grip are few and in constant danger.

The following is a letter, reprinted for the first time in former Ghanaian President Kwame Nkrumah's new book "Challenge of the Congo," written by Lumumba to his wife shortly before his execution by Western puppet troops.

It is the Congo, it is our poor people for whom independence has been transformed into a cage from whose confines the outside world looks on us, sometimes with kindly sympathy, but at other times with joy and pleasure.

But my faith remains unshakeable. I know and I feel in my heart that sooner or later my people will rid themselves of all their enemies, both internal and external, and that they will rise as one man to say No to the degradation and shame of colonialism, and regain their dignity in the clear



QUESTION: In Fauquier County, Va., there is a clinic that seeks to get black women to have hysterectomy operations (surgical removal of the uterus, where the baby is nourished and developed before birth). And on the West Coast, a Puerto Rican woman, arrested in a house where police found marijuana, was given the choice by the judge of being sterilized and having all charges dropped or going to jail.

We realize that many people may want to limit the size of their families for various reasons, but we don't think this should be done in a way to permanently prevent people from producing, except in the cases of malfunctioning organs or terribly diseased organs. What is your thinking on this?

ANSWER: I completely agree with you. I think that experience in Virginia, as I understand it, is outrageous and criminal.





OIL CONSORTIUM YIELDS ON IRAN OIL

Mr. Romeo Horton, Liberia's Secretary of Commerce, said he hoped this cooperation would strengthen the free trade agreements already concluded by Liberia, Ivory Coast, Sierra Leone and Guinea.

#### NIGERIA HOSTS RUBBER STUDY CONFERENCE

Lagos, Nigeria (AAPS) - Twenty-nine independent countries and six international organizations were represented at the 18th Assembly of the International Rubber Study Group here.



### Unborn Infant Sensitive To Pain?

LONDON - A top-rated professor of obstetrics and gynecology has asserted that as early as 10 weeks after conception a human fetus is sensitive to pain.

DR. JAMES Scott, professor at Leeds University and a committee member of the newly-launched Society for the Protection of Unborn Children, claimed recently that the fetus' sensitivity to pain was definitely established.

His experience of intrauterine surgery to correct rhesus conditions had given him pictures on an X-ray screen of "babies writhing and struggling to get off the

"Pain is something you can only prove in yourself," Professor Scott said. "But their reaction is the same as that of a human being in pain. It is quite different from a simple reflex, which is only one movement."

Most of this surgery is done at 20 or more weeks after conception, whereas therapeutic abortions are usually fessor Scott has operated on one fetus at 10 weeks and observed the same reaction.

A Cambridge embryologist, Dr. H. M. Woollam (whose own view on abortion is "You don't know what you're losing"), said he did not believe that pain as we understood it was felt by the fetus but it would be difficult to prove. "I couldn't prove that a lettuce didn't feel,"

The popularly held view is that even though the nervous system was formed in the fetus, it was not totally function cactive until after birth.



### New Book Reveals Lincoln as Racist With Colonization Plans for Negroes

NEW YORK-A new book on civil rights reveals Abraham Lincoln as having plans to ship Negroes back to Africa even as he sought to liberate them.

THE BOOK, entitled "The Invention of the Negro," by well-known author, Earl Conrad, reveals the true racist character of the so-'Great Emancicalled pator."

Continuously mis - represented as a martyr, Lincoln is quoted as telling Negroes late in 1862 that "you and I are different races. Whether it is right or wrong I need not discuss. But this physical difference is a great disadvantage to us both, as I think your race suffers very greatly, many of them by living among us, while ours suffers from your presence. In a word, we suffer on each side. If this be admitted, it affords a reason why at least should be separated."

The author of the book declares that Lincoln then "proposed colonization away from the United States" as the "only postwar solution that appeared clear to him.







# The Muslim Program

### What the Muslims Want

This is the question asked most frequently by both the whites and the blacks. The answers to this question I shall state as simply as possible.

1. We want freedom. We want a full and complete freedom.

2. We want justice. Equal justice under the law. We want justice applied equally to all, regardless of creed or class or color.

3. We want equality of opportunity. We want equal membership in society with the

best in civilized society.

4. We want our people in America whose parents or grandparents were descendants from slaves, to be allowed to establish a separate state or territory of their own—either on this continent or elsewhere. We believe that our former slave masters are obligated to provide such land and that the area must be fertile and minerally rich. We believe that our former slave masters are obligated to maintain and supply our needs in this separate territory for the next 20 to 25 years—until we are able to produce and supply our own needs.

Since we cannot get along with them in peace and equality, after giving them 400 years of our sweat and blood and receiving in return some of the worst treatment human beings have ever experienced, we believe our contributions to this land and the suffering forced upon us by white America, justifies our demand for complete separation in a state or territory of our own.

5. We want freedom for all Believers of Islam now held in federal prisons. We want freedom for all black men and women now under death sentence in innumerable prisons

in the North as well as the South.

We want every black man and woman to have the freedom to accept or reject being ated from the slave master's children tablish a land of their own.

the black and white conflict is the best answer to the problem between two 6. We want an immediate end to the police brutality and mob attacks against the so-called Negro throughout the United States.

We believe that the Federal government should intercede to see that black men and women tried in white courts receive justice in accordance with the laws of the land—or allow us to build a new nation for ourselves, dedicated to justice, freedom and liberty.

7. As long as we are not allowed to establish a state or territory of our own, we demand not only equal justice under the laws of the United States, but equal employment

opportunities-NOW!

We do not believe that after 400 years of free or nearly free labor, sweat and blood, which has helped America become rich and powerful, that so many thousands of black people should have to subsist on relief, charity or live in poor houses.

8. We want the government of the United States to exempt our people from ALL taxation as long as we are deprived of equal jus-

tice under the laws of the land.

9. We want equal education—but separate schools up to 16 for boys and 18 for girls on the condition that the girls be sent to women's colleges and universities. We want all black children educated, taught and trained by their own teachers.

Under such schooling system we believe we will make a better nation of people. The United States government should provide, free, all necessary text books and equipment, schools and college buildings. The Muslim teachers shall be left free to teach and train their people in the way of righteousness, decency and self respect.

10. We believe that intermarriage or race mixing should be prohibited. We want the religion of Islam taught without hinderance or suppression.

These are some of the things that we, the Muslims, want for our people in North America.

8. WE BELIEVE in justice for all, whether in God or not; we believe as others, that we are due equal justice as human beings. We believe in equality—as a nation — of equals. We do not believe that we are equal with our slave masters in the status of "freed slaves."

We recognize and respect American citizens as independent peoples and we respect their laws which govern this nation.

9. WE BELIEVE that the offer of integration is hypocritical and is made by those who are trying to deceive the black peoples into believing that their 400-year-old open enemies of freedom, justice and equality are, all of a sudden, their "friends." Furthermore, we believe that such deception is intended to prevent black people from realizing that the time in history has arrived for the separation from the whites of this nation.

If the white people are truthful about their professed friendship toward the socalled Negro, they can prove it by dividing up America with their slaves.

We do not believe that America will ever be able to furnish enough jobs for her own millions of unemployed, in addition to jobs for the 20,000,000 black people as well.

10. WE BELIEVE that we who declared ourselves to be righteous Muslims, should not participate in wars which take the lives of humans. We do not believe this nation should force us to take part in such wars. for we have nothing to gain from it unless America agrees to give us the necessary territory wherein we may have something to fight for.

11. WE BELIEVE our women should be respected and protected as the women of other nationalities are respected and protected.

12. WE BELIEVE that Allah (God) appeared in the Person of Master W. Fard Muhammad, July, 1930; the long-awaited "Messiah" of the Christians and the "Mahdi" of the Muslims.

We believe further and lastly that Allah is God and besides HIM there is no God and He will bring about a universal government of peace wherein we all can live in peace together.

### What the Muslims Believe

- 1. WE BELIEVE in the One God Whose proper Name is Allah.
- 2. WE BELIEVE in the Holy Qur-an and in the Scriptures of all the Prophets of God.
- 3. WE BELIEVE in the truth of the Bible, but we believe that it has been tampered with and must be reinterpreted so that mankind will not be snared by the falsehoods that have been added to it.
- 4. WE BELIEVE in Allah's Prophets and the Scriptures they brought to the people.
- 5. WE BELIEVE in the resurrection of the dead—not in physical resurrection—but in mental resurrection. We believe that the so-called Negroes are most in need of mental resurrection; therefore, they will be resurrected first.
- Furthermore, we believe we are the people of God's choice, as it has been written, that God would choose the rejected and the despised. We can find no other persons fitting this description in these last days more than the so-called Negroes in America. We believe in the resurrection of the righteous.
- 6. WE BELIEVE in the judgement; we believe this first judgement will take place as God revealed, in America . . .
- 7. WE BELIEVE this is the time in history for the separation of the so-called Negroes and the so-called white Americans. We believe the black man should be freed in name as well as in fact. By this we mean that he should be freed from the names imposed upon him by his former slave masters. Names which identified him as being the slave master's slave. We believe that if we are free indeed, we should go in our own people's names—the black peoples of the earth.
