



Most Tragic Story of 1966

Death of Black Gl's in White Man's Viet Nam War

WASHINGTON-The most tragic story of the year 1966 is the ruthless use of black troops as buffers by white America in the bloody, barbaric aggression against the people of Viet Nam.

THE INCREASINGLY disproportionate number of black troops slaughtered in the genocidal conflict is spurring more and more Negro leaders to castigate the blatantly - rigged U.S. draft policies which permit deferment of youths economically fortunate enough to attend college and doom the poverty-stricken, ghettodwelling majority to involuntary military service.

"America's use of Negro cannon - fodder against the black man's brother in Viet Nam follows the same pattern as the use of Africans and Asians to conquer and oppress Africa and Asia for hundreds of years by British, French, American and Portuguese imperialists," an African diplomat recently said on the floor of the United Nations General Assembly.

An Asian representative to the United Nations pointed out recently that "if it were not for the fact that mainly black youths are slaughtered in Viet Nam, white citizens of America would have demanded U.S. withdrawal from Viet Nam long ago."







Plot to Lynch' Powell May Hang

(Pan African Press)

WASHINGTON - Almost as though America's traffic in black slaves was historically uninterrupted, an odd assortment of lily-white, holier - than - thou Congressmen here have proceeded amidst the gleeful clamor of the white press to sell down the river the nation's most courageous and brainiest legislator, Harlem's A. Clayton Powell.

THE CRUDE political destruction of the black Congressman, who for decades supported and led countless crusades for the equality and justice of black Americans, is being staged here unashamedly and with the same brazen disregard for world opinion as demonstrated by Hitler when he sought to destroy the Jews.

Powell has remained quiet during most of the lynch preparations. They center around a kangaroo-type socalled "investigation" of his expense accounts and the activities of his high calibre

It is well known, however, that their fear of Powell stems mainly from his able use of his seniority powers as head of the important House Committee on Education and Labor—a post covand one which Powell has handled with increasing effectiveness.

Powell now believes that his decision not to speak out against the plot has thus far fostered a public misrepresentation of his strong feelings on the matter.

"HOW MUCH," he asked, "is all this a part of the convulsion of change - the beginning of the new era of the rejected Negro, an organized turning of white America's back on black people?

"The following facts speak for themselves:

"1.) In the past 50 years, not a single Congressman has ever been denied his seat by the House of Repsentatives.

"2.) Of the present 20 House Committee chairmanships, only two are held by Negroes. I am one of the two. Thus, Negroes would lose both their sec-

ond highest ranking Negro Congressman as well as one of the only two committee chairmanships we

"3.) Of the present 435 Congressmen, only six or one per cent-are Negroes. To consider unseating even one of these Negro Congressmen, particularly the second highest ranking one in terms of years of service, is to scissor a full one-sixth of the political power of the already miserably underrepresented and wretchedly powerless black people.

"4.) There are more Negroes on my Congressional staff than on any of the 535 Congressmen and Senators' staffs-and that includes those who are most loudly committed verbally to civil rights.


"5.) There are more Negro employees on my committee—the Education and Labor Committee—than on any of the 36 committees in both the House and the Senate. In fact, half of the

24 full committee staff members are Negro. The move to unseat me or have me step aside is also a move to fire 12 well-paid Negro staff members. Racial big otry in employment in the House of Representatives is one of the critical problems confronting America today.

"6.) The voters of the 18th Congressional District of New York State reelected me to my 12th term by one of the largest margins of any of the contested Congressional races -74.1 per cent-a percentage far higher than that of many of whom are seeking to unseat me. 

disease for some five years. In July of this year, his father brought him to the Chinese doctors. After carefu examination, it was found that the patient was suffering from mitral stenosis, curable only by an intricate operation. Although the hospital lacked the necessary medical equipment and drugs for such an operation, the devoted surgeons, acting on Mao Tse-Tung's teachings, carefully studied all possible eventualities, thoroughly prepared themselves in every way and even practiced on an animal with their meager equipment before the operation.

They achieved the first successful heart operation in the history of Somalia. Afterwards, the entire Chinese team helped nurse the patient, maintaining a 24-hour watch beside the recovering patient's bed for a week.

"TO WATCH over a patient throughout the night is something doctors from Western countries have never done," a Somali friend said. After more than 20 days, the young patient left the hospital fully recovered.

A four-year-old named Ibrahim, who had an obstruction in his wind pipe, was in most critical condition, scarcely able to breath and had not eaten for severa! days when the Chinese doctors examined him. Though lacking proper facilities, the doctors built up the child's strength with fluid transfusions, then performed a tracheotomy operation to temporarily relieve his difficulty in breathing.

Due to the lad's low resistance he contracted staphylococci pneumonia and repeatedly sank into suffocation. The Chinese doctors, working in coordination with Somali nurses, took turns caring for the boy who was at death's door. They injected Chinese - made illotycin to fight off more serious infec-

In desperation, as a last effort, the Chinese surgeons

performed a high trachetomy operation on little Ibrahim, using a broken trachoscope and without electric light. Carefully exploring his windpipe with a probe, they finally dislodged a plastic pearl from the patient's windpipe. Little Ibrahim was saved.

A pregnant Somali woman. who was saved from eclampria by a Chinese doctor Hung Su-Ying, named her first son "Hung You-Yi," which means "friendship" in honor of the doctor.

Chinese medical team can now converse with their patients, a great help in diagnosing ills.

"I TRY always to be prepared to meet any crisis, to use initiative in my work, and display enthusiasm for the job at hand. These attributes are important considerations for foreign service employes."



Urge New Nations To Control Crime

NEW YORK - A group of specialists meeting here has every cultural form. 



AN INTERNATIONAL RELIEF committee was formed to speed emergency food aid to famine-stricken

"What world governments are doing is too little, too late in the present situation," said the World Food and Population Crisis Committee in announcing its forma-

"Millions of people in (the state of) Bihar are now or will be starving," said Rodney Clurman, a Quaker who spear-headed formation of the group and will serve as its executive secretary.

GEN. WILLIAM WESTMORELAND, commander of United States forces in Viet Nam, said he will need more troops to fight the war there. There are 372,000 American troops there now.

Westmoreland said on an ABC-TV program that "the tide has turned in our favor during the year 1966." But he cautioned that the length of the war must be measured in years and that "more troops will be needed from our country and, hopefully, from the free world allies."

"We must prepare ourselves for what the Communists call a protracted war," he said. "The time involved is not measured in months, it's measured in years."

CAMBODIA HAS BROKEN all relations with South Korea, the Cambodian state radio announced. A note to this effect was delivered to the South Korean consulategeneral, the broadcast said, but no details on the reason for the break were given."

> SEVENTY-FIVE PERSONS were killed and 613 injured in road accidents in France during the Christmas week-end, it was reported. Road accidents last year claimed 85 lives for the three-day holiday.

> A VIOLENT EARTHQUAKE rocked northern Chile and heavy casualties were feared in the nitrate port of Taltal, the center of the upheaval.

> The Chilean news agency Orbe said 80 per cent of the buildings in Taltal were destroyed but the number of dead and injured was not known yet. The town, 700 miles north of Santiago, has a population of about 6,000.

THE LEADER OF the Illinois Democrats in Washington said that further cuts in the administration's war on poverty can be expected when Congress convenes.

ALMOST HALF of a group of key Democratic leaders either believe their party would be better off with a candidate other than President Johnson in 1968 or are currently unwilling to indorse his renomination.

However, few among 125 leading Democrats in 30 states interviewed by the New York Times were rash enough to predict that Johnson would be challenged for the nomination or lose it if he should be challenged.



3. We want equality of opportunity. We want equal membership in society with the best in civilized society.

9. We want equal education—but separate schools up to 16 for boys and 18 for girls on the condition that the girls be sent to women's colleges and universities. We want all black children educated, taught and trained by their own teachers.

8. WE BELIEVE in justice for all, whether in God or not; we believe as others, that we are due equal justice as human beings. We believe in equality—as a nation — of equals. We do not believe that we are equal with our slave masters in the status of "freed

We recognize and respect American citizens as independent peoples and we respect their laws which govern this nation.

9. WE BELIEVE that the offer of integration is hypocritical and is made by those who are trying to deceive the black peoples into believing that their 400-year-old open enemies of freedom, justice and equality are, all of a sudden, their "friends." Furthermore, we believe that such deception is intended to prevent black people from realizing that the time in history has arrived for the separation from the whites of this nation.

If the white people are truthful about their professed friendship toward the socalled Negro, they can prove it by dividing up America with their slaves.

We do not believe that America will ever be able to furnish enough jobs for her own millions of unemployed, in addition to jobs for the 20,000,000 black people as well.

10. WE BELIEVE that we who declared ourselves to be righteous Muslims, should not participate in wars which take the lives of humans. We do not believe this nation should force us to take part in such wars, for we have nothing to gain from it unless America agrees to give us the necessary territory wherein we may have something to fight for.

11. WE BELIEVE our women should be respected and protected as the women of other nationalities are respected and protected.

12. WE BELIEVE that Allah (God) appeared in the Person of Master W. Fard Muhammad, July, 1930; the long-awaited "Messiah" of the Christians and the "Mahdi" of the Muslims.

We believe further and lastly that Allah is God and besides HIM there is no God and He will bring about a universal government of peace wherein we all can live in peace to-

- 1. WE BELIEVE in the One God Whose proper Name is Allah.
- 2. WE BELIEVE in the Holy Qur-an and in the Scriptures of all the Prophets of God.
- 3. WE BELIEVE in the truth of the Bible, and must be reinterpreted so that mankind will not be snared by the falsehoods that have been added to it.
- 4. WE BELIEVE in Allah's Prophets and the Scriptures they brought to the people.

We can find no other persons fitting this description in these last days more than the so-called Negroes in America. We believe in the resurrection of the righteous.
- 6. WE BELIEVE in the judgement; believe this first judgement will take place as God revealed, in America . . .
- 7. WE BELIEVE this is the time in history for the separation of the so-called Negroes and the so-called white Americans. We believe the black man should be freed in name as well as in fact. By this we mean that he should be freed from the names imposed upon him by his former slave masters. Names which identified him as being the slave master's slave. We believe that if we are free indeed, we should go in our own people's names—the black peoples of the earth.
